## APPLICANT MUST:

- Be a resident of Springfield, MA
- Be accepted into an accredited two or four-year college or university. Submit all required documentation listed below
- Minimum GPA of 3.0 or higher
- Recipients must attend The Education Matters Scholarship event on April 29th, 2022, 10 am-12:45 pm
- Recipients must be available to volunteer at two (or more) Parent Villages' events. The application deadline is strictly upheld

## REQUIRED DOCUMENTS:

- Fully Completed Education Matters Scholarship
- Financial Aid Award Letter
- College/University Acceptance Letter (once received)
- Most current High School Academic Transcript (with cumulative GPA shown)
- 2 Letters of Recommendation—one personal, one from a school professional (teacher, guidance counselor, principal, etc.)

## TIMELINE

**Monday, January 2nd: The application opens**

**Monday, March 27th: The application closes**

- Week of March 27th: Scholarship recipients are chosen
- First week of April: Applicants are notified if they did or did not receive a scholarship. Awardees will be formally invited to the Education Matters Scholarship Brunch
- **Saturday, April 29th: 5th Annual Education Matters Scholarship Brunch**
- August/September: Scholarship recipients will be notified about various opportunities to earn their Volunteer hours
- September/October: Scholarship funds will be distributed
